The Gift That Includes All Others



The following article is gently lifted from the *Berean Searchlight*, December 2018, by Pastor Paul M. Sadler:

Whether the occasion is a holiday, a birthday celebration, or a graduation, it is customary to give a gift. While some gifts are given out of necessity, a gift, for the most part is an expression of our love. We normally bestow these tokens of our affection on those whom we feel deserve the honor. But God's ways are not our ways. He gave the gift of His beloved Son to His *enemies*. That's a true story! Oh, the wonder of His grace that God sent His only begotten Son, the Son of His love, to save sinners like you and me while we were fleeing from the glory of His presence. Little wonder the Apostle Paul says, "Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift" (2 Cor. 9:15).

The word "unspeakable" here has the idea of "indescribable." The gifts I've received through the years were all describable. Some may have been a little harder to describe than others, but describable nonetheless. But the gift of God's dear Son is *indescribable*. Who can explain the incarnation: how the eternal Son of God left heaven's glory and took upon Himself the form of human flesh, yet was not tainted with our sin? Who can explain how Christ was wholly God and wholly human in one person? These wonders can only be received through the eye of faith.

Their voices through the night air rang.


God Rest You Merry Gentlemen




